Toll Roads update:

Al Tracey has been on radio twice about proposed Toll Roads. It's being billed as a

partnership between public and private sector. Centra, a spanish firm, is building all the Toll

roads. The I-93 from Vegas-Wickenberg-Phoenix-Casa Grande is called the CanaMex

interstate which will run from Mexico to Canada. These roads are really for big companies

like Walmart to ship their goods quickly from Mexico the the US and Canada. It will cost

approximately 130 million per mile to build. The "Partnership" is that is the private company

Final items: Sun City Car show flyers distributed.



Bo Shaw's Restoration Journal

This is the eighth and ninth of a series of 16 articles written by DCTRA member Bo Shaw about his experiences restoring his 1958 TR3A. Each month we will publish another article (or two if they are short) so you can see what it's like to spend a year or more recording your progress on a major project's ups and down's and the final TRIUMPHant result.

TR3A Activity - January 2012

Slow going over the last month, mostly due to the holidays and two weeks spent in Phoenix.

The good news is that the engine for the TR3A is now running without any further major trauma. I indeed had not set the soft plug in the back of the head hard enough and the pressure of the coolant system had blown it out. So, having removed the head and reset the soft plug, we again tried an engine start. This time the engine caught and raced immediately to well north of the recommended 2000 rpm. It was immediately shut down and the cause traced to a maladjustment of the carburetors, which was corrected. After removing, adjusting and reinstalling the carburetors, the engine started immediately and ran smoothly...with the exception of the white smoke billowing up from the exhaust system. This was traced to coolant leaking onto the insulation wrap on the headers that resulted in it boiling off when they heated up. The next start up resulted in a very nice 30 minute engine run. The motor is very smooth, has a nice, throaty sound and runs up in rpms very quickly. (A picture is enclosed of us getting ready for the engine run up.)

Since the engine run, I have been focused on chasing down the oil and coolant leaks (more later) revealed during the engine run and starting to install some interior items. I ordered a door capping kit from TRF and took this kit and the rest of the old cockpit capping to Reber's Upholstery for it to be repaired and recovered. He did his usual excellent job and I have



This, of course, is never as easy as anticipated, and, in this case I spent several hours filing the outside mount for the grab handle so that it would fit and allow the glove box door to open. (The material used by Reber is somewhat thicker (read better quality) than the original with resulting clearance problems.)



The coolant leaks are due to leaking drain taps on the side of the engine and base of the radiator, and to a bad casting on a brand new thermostat cover. One of the leaking drain taps is also brand new. (The Red Menace, China, strikes again! And Again. And Again. I'm getting so that I look back at the sometimes defective, poorly fitting parts that came out of Taiwan with fond remembrance.) The leaking thermostat cover was replaced with the 52+ year old (British made) part that it replaced, and this old part works just fine. Next month I hope to correct the leaks, resurrect the brakes and clutch, attach the fenders and hood, complete the interior...and win the Mega Lottery. (Winning the lottery is the most likely scenario.)

TR3A Activity - March 2012

As left off last month, the TR3 was beset by drain tap leaks from the radiator and the engine block and what seemed to be a "frozen" clutch pedal.

Frozen Clutch Pedal: The "frozen" clutch pedal turned out to be nothing but my own paranoia (however well deserved), i.e., just a stiff pedal return spring.

Leaking Drain Taps: After finding that Moss did not have any drain taps available either, I attempted to source some used drain taps from Ted Schumacher (TS Imported Automotive), who went through his used parts stockpile only to find that he did not have any. At Ted's suggestion, I went to the local radiator shop (corner or Mahan and Ridgecrest blvd) and obtained two stopcocks. (The shop owner sold me both for a very reasonable \$5. The new drain taps (leaking variety) were \$15 each.) On trying the stopcocks, I found that they worked very well on the radiator, but were too large for the engine block application. Back to square one. West came over with several drain taps that he had scavenged from his various blocks, but for one reason or another (usually the result of long and honorable hard service) these did not work out. We were discussing modifying one of these taps when I remembered (finally) that I had an extra TR engine block of my own sitting in a corner of the garage. Another drain tap! I worked this one over with WD40 and Kroil, letting it sit over night. The next day I was able to work the lever and it passed the leak test. It has been installed on my engine block for three weeks now it has not leaked a drop. As has been the case in the past, an issue with a new (defective) part has been resolved by one manufactured in England over fifty years ago. Hail Britannia!

Choke Cable Too Short: The one remaining issue from the conversion to the TR4 HS6 SU carburetors was the choke cable. The cable for the original TR3 H6 carburetors was not quite long enough. When comparing my existing TR3A choke cable to a used spare TR4 choke cable that West had, we discovered that the TR4 cable was about six inches longer. When installed in the TR3, it was the perfect length! It could even be modified to accept the TR3 control head. I now need to find a replacement for West.

Miscellaneous: Otherwise, the past month has been mishmash of details. Some additional body trim items were installed. The rear brake shoes were adjusted. Roy decided to have his "hood sticks" sand blasted and powder coated at Valley Fence, so West and I decided to go in with him. I've started reinstalling the latch hardware in the doors. A tonneau cover was ordered from TRF.

Plan for Next Month: I still have to verify that my oil leak has been cured via an engine run. If it still leaks I will have to remove the oil filter mount and re-install it. Regardless of the engine leak result, I will start installing front body pieces, starting with the front apron and passenger side, front fender.
