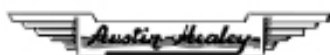

VISITORS: Mark & Heidi Greenfield from Bonnie Lake, WA attended Triumphest and then came to Phoenix to visit. At home they have a TR3A, a TR4, a '74 TR6, a '73 Stag and an '80 TR8.

New member Mike Blachut lives in Sun City and recently purchased a TR3. His friend and neighbor, Maggie Austin attended the meeting with him.

New members Chip & Caren Heidinger live in NE Mesa and have a '76 TR6.

New member Carl Butler works for Bob Branton and has a Stag. He moved here recently from Wilmington, NC.

MINUTES: The September 11, 2012 minutes were approved after correcting the spelling of Penny Branton's name.

TREASURER: John Reynolds reported on the club's account balances. He added that the club needs to open a new CD to prepare for the next Triumphest that we host.

MEMBERSHIP: Trudy Crable reported on new members.

NEWSLETTER: Dave Riddle said the newsletter was out.

AAHC: John Horton reported that Maricopa County is the only county in Arizona and Arizona is the only state in the U.S. that tests motorcycles for emissions. He spoke in favor of SB#1324 that will exempt all 1974 and older vehicles from emissions testing. He warned us about House Bill #2491 which adds "another layer of taxation" by authorizing public-private partnerships to build toll roads in Arizona. He said Speed World will remain open and is not closing as reported previously. He announced that October 18th is "National Alternative Fuel Day" and that the AAHC will hold a car show at Sanderson Ford on Febru-

ary 2, 2013.

OWNERSHIP UPDATES: Linda Nicholson reported that her grandson, Tim Titus, recently purchased an MGBGT.

EVENTS: Matt Reynolds reported on several events (All British Breakfast Run, Wings & Wheels, Orphans Car Show, British Vintage Voyage, etc.) that will have occurred before these minutes are published. TECHNICAL: Armand LaCasse told about a scare on the drive home from Triumphest that turned out to only be the antifreeze overflow container leaking.

Jim Bauder talked about an oil leak, a gasket with a hole in it, and having to pull the exhaust manifold to replace twisted off studs on his TR250. He thanked John Truttman for helping by loaning him his helicoil kit. Jim also spoke about a Corvette-powered TR6 at Triumphest and said he would like to have pictures of the installation.

John Horton said he got his Locost Lotus 7 engine back and will drive the car to the Breakfast Run this weekend.

OLD BUSINESS: After no one else volunteered, Pete & Bev Peterson offered to hold the Christmas Party at their house on Saturday, December 15.

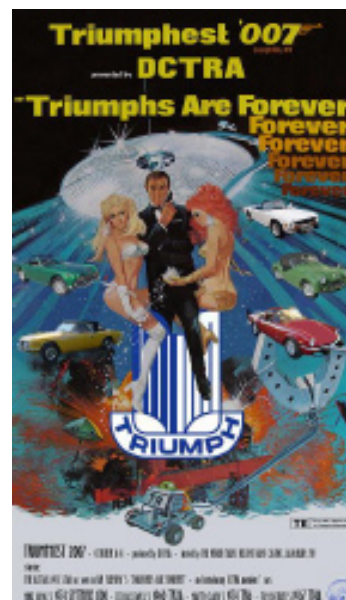

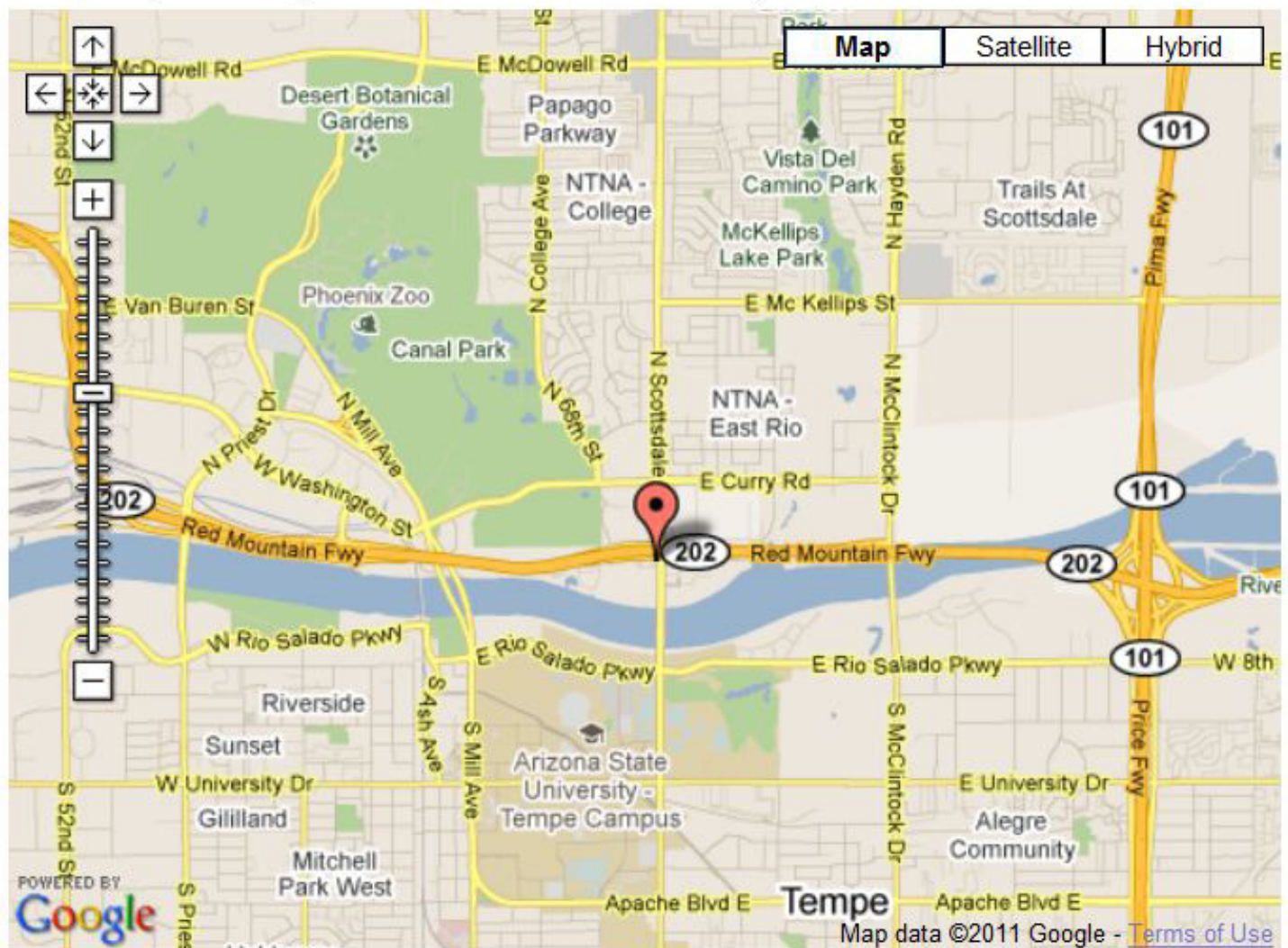
