VISITORS: There were no visitors.

#### MINUTES:

The August 14, 2012 minutes, as published in the September newsletter, were approved after being corrected to show that Beth Horton took the minutes and to add that John Reynolds said club car badges were almost sold out.

#### TREASURER:

John Reynolds reported on the club's account balances. He added that he hasn't paid any bills yet for Triumphest 2012.

AAHC: John Horton reported on the meeting

held recently at Sanderson Ford where, among other topics, legislation concerning toll roads in Arizona and RFI stations to issue automatic speeding tickets were discussed. John urged everyone to contact their representative to protest toll roads as an additional tax on motorists. He also said the next AAHC meeting would be held on the east side.

OWNERSHIP UPDATES: There were no reports.

EVENTS: John Horton will host a workshop on Saturday, September 17 to prepare for Triumphest. Other events were announced but they

Gears." He added that he's been working on reconditioning a 60-year old valve grinding machine that had belonged to Bob Schaller.

Jim Bauder talked about a "clunk" in the rear end of his TR250. Examination of the differential was inconclusive. He ended up replacing bad U-joints and seals and bushings. He mentioned that care must be taken not to let the spring pop out when replacing the seal.

John Nuss said 13" racing tires are virtually impossible to find any more. Others commented on this problem.

George Montgomery said he has a new left front turn signal lens for sale that will fit a TR6.

John Horton also had some parts that he had made for sale, including throttle linkage bushing sets for \$10.00 each and mounting blocks for a steering rack. These are for a TR250/TR6.

Gene Glenn talked about changing the intake manifold on his TR4.

OLD BUSINESS: John Reynolds asked if he should order more car badges. A show of hands indicated that at least 10 members would like to purchase one.

NEW BUSINESS: George Montgomery said we need to get plans for the Christmas Party in progress by the next meeting and asked for someone to volunteer to hold it at their home. He also asked about the Champagne Brunch in January. Everyone seemed to agree that the Landmark Restaurant would be acceptable again this year.






